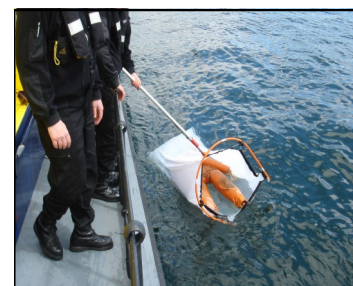
Using the SB Rescue Sling

1. Place the harness around the casualty in the water. This may be from the legs or from the head
 Bring the harness up under the arms of the casualty
2. Pull on the line to release the harness from the frame
 Push on the handle to tighten the harness around the casualty
3. Remove the frame
4. Recover the casualty by manually hauling on the line or by use of a manual, electric or hydraulic winch.



The **SB Rescue Sling** is supplied as standard with a 1m aluminium handle and an aluminium telescopic boat hook extension handle.

The telescopic range of the extension boat hook is 1.7 - 3.0m. giving a total handle length of 4.0m. When connected to the frame the overall length is nearly 5.2m. giving the unit an effective reach in excess of 4.5m.



When fitted with a forensic bag the **SB Rescue Sling** is used by various police authorities as an effective body recovery system

Length of handle and telescopic extension	4.0m. Other lengths on request

Maximum effective freeboard	4.5+ m.
Material – Frame & Handle	Anodised aluminium

* Users may substitute a suitable alternative line appropriate to their recovery system
